

MINUTES OF THE SCHOOL BOARD
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
September 18, 2017 6:30 P.M.

The Grand Saline ISD Board of Trustees met in a regular meeting this date. President Rodney Easley called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. stating that a quorum was present and the meeting had been duly called and posted in the time and manner required by law.

Board members present included President Rodney Easley, Vice President Matt Strickland, Secretary Micah Lowe, Bear Brown, Jeremiah Carnes, and Paul Moreno. Eddie Paul Stanley was absent.

The invocation was led by Superintendent Micah Lewis followed by the pledge of allegiance.

There were no comments from the public.
